### **Bake Sale:**

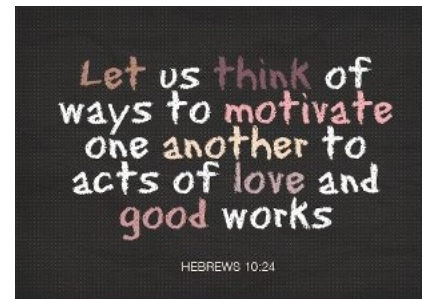
